



Anchoring II

DESCRIPTION	MV Seabass calls Koper Harbour Master to inform them about dropping anchor. Koper Harbour Master also informs the ship about potential issues with their AIS system.	
PARTICIPANTS	Harbour Master operator, officer on the bridge	
PROMPTS	Vessel	Call Koper Harbour Master.
	Harbour Master	Answer the call and establish contact.
	Vessel	Inform Koper Harbour Master about the time when you dropped anchor (18:10).
	Harbour Master	Ask the ship for their position. Indicate that the ship's AIS position maybe is wrong.
	Vessel	Confirm that you are in the correct position.
	Harbour Master	Inform the ship that they are in anchoring position Alpha 2. Ask them to repeat the time when they dropped anchor.
	Vessel	Answer the question.
	Harbour Master	Tell the ship to keep listening on channel 08. Ask the ship again to check their AIS.
	Vessel	Confirm receiving any information provided by the Harbour Master. Confirm that you will do what the Harbour Master asked you to do.
	Harbour Master	Ask the ship again to check their AIS (your AIS shows that their position is two cables NE of the expected position).
	Vessel	Acknowledge the Harbour Master's information.
	Harbour Master	Thank the ship and politely close the call.
