



## Anchoring I

DESCRIPTION	Koper Harbour Master calls MV Seabass to inform the ship about changing the previously suggested anchoring position due to the nature of the cargo that the ship is carrying.	
PARTICIPANTS	Harbour Master operator, officer on the bridge	
PROMPTS	Harbour Master	Call MV Seabass.
	Vessel	Answer the call and establish contact.
	Harbour Master	Inform the ship about the change in the anchoring position because of the cargo that she is carrying.
	Vessel	Confirm readiness to receive information.
	Harbour Master	Provide the new anchoring position (Bravo 3). Repeat the position.
	Vessel	Confirm receiving the new position and confirm that you will drop anchor there.
	Harbour Master	Provide the ship with the coordinates of this position (45° 34.30' N 013° 41.75' E).
	Vessel	Read back the given coordinates.
	Harbour Master	Confirm the coordinates are correct.
	Vessel	Request a repetition of the longitude because the connection was poor.
	Harbour Master	Repeat the longitude of the said position.
	Vessel	Read back the given longitude. Ask for the confirmation that this is the correct position.
	Harbour Master	Confirm this is the correct position. Inform the ship that they should proceed to anchorage position Bravo 3. Inform them to notify the Harbour Master on channel 08 once anchored.
	Vessel	Confirm receiving the information and politely close the call.
	Harbour Master	Thank the ship and close the call politely.
