



Bunkering in certain anchorage area

DESCRIPTION	The vessel Angelshark calls the VTS station to report about their entering the VTS area, bound for the bunkering area and asks for directions and advice. The VTS station advises them where to anchor and informs them of traffic along the fairway.
PARTICIPANTS	Vessel Traffic Services Operator, Officer of the watch
PROMPTS	<p>VTSO</p> <p>The VTS received a call from a vessel bound for the bunkering area. The VTSO asks for draft and intention after bunkering. The VTSO informs about two vessels underway in the same fairway, one inbound and one outbound. The VTSO also advises where the vessel should anchor for bunkering and gives information of two other vessels that are anchored nearby, also soon to be underway. The VTSO asks the vessel to call back when entering the anchorage position, before dropping anchor.</p> <hr/> <p>Officer on the bridge</p> <p>The vessel contacts the VTS station, as she is entering the VTS area, underway to the anchorage area for bunkering, and asks for directions and anchoring instructions. The vessel answers all the VTS questions and confirms the information received from the VTSO.</p>
