



### Entering Sector 5 of the Adriatic Reporting System

DESCRIPTION	Koper MRCC uses channel 12 to contact MV Seabass as she is entering Sector 5 of the Adriatic Reporting System. The MRCC operator needs to obtain certain information about the vessel before she enters the area, and provide the ship with necessary details.	
PARTICIPANTS	MRCC operator, officer on the bridge	
PROMPTS	MRCC	Call MV Seabass.
	Vessel	Answer the call and establish contact.
	MRCC	Ask about the ship's arrival time to Koper pilot station.
	Vessel	The estimated time of arrival to Koper pilot station is 15:45. Repeat this information.
	MRCC	Ask about any dangerous goods on board.
	Vessel	Dangerous goods on board belong to IMO class 3.
	MRCC	Ask about the quantity of dangerous goods.
	Vessel	The quantity is 70,482 kg.
	MRCC	Ask for the number of persons on board.
	Vessel	23 crewmembers.
	MRCC	Provide of the following information:  1) according to berthing prospects, the pilot boarding time is 24:00 local time;  2) upon approach, MV Seabass should contact the Harbour Master for the anchoring position;  3) the maximum speed limit within the port is 6 knots.
	Vessel	Confirm receiving the information on the speed limit within the port.
	MRCC	Instruct the ship to keep monitoring channels 12 and 16.
	Vessel	Confirm receiving this information and politely close the call.
