



Speed limit

DESCRIPTION	MV Seabass calls Koper Harbour Master to ask about the speed limit within the port.	
PARTICIPANTS	Harbour Master operator, officer on the bridge	
PROMPTS	Vessel	Call Koper Harbour Master. Your call sign is ZE57W.
	Harbour Master	Answer the call and establish contact.
	Vessel	Ask for the speed limit in port.
	Harbour Master	Answer the question (the speed limit is 6 knots). Provide the longitude where the port limit starts (013° 40'E). Ask the ship if they received this information.
	Vessel	Request the Harbour Master to repeat this information.
	Harbour Master	Repeat the longitude where the port limit starts. Ask the ship if they received this information.
	Vessel	Read back the given latitude. Ask the Harbour Master to confirm if this is correct.
	Harbour Master	Confirm the said position. Inform the ship that eastward from that longitude the maximum speed is 6 knots.
	Vessel	Repeat the information (eastward from that longitude the speed must be at least 6 knots).
	Harbour Master	Correct the ship by explaining that eastward from that position, the speed must be 6 knots or less. Maximum speed is 6 knots.
	Vessel	Confirm receiving the corrected information provided by the Harbour Master.
	Harbour Master	Confirm the maximum speed and politely close the call.
