Vessel adrift

DESCRIPTION	VTS calls the vessel Codfish as they discover it is moving irregularly according to its AIS.
PARTICIPANTS	Vessel Traffic Services Operator, Officer of the watch
PROMPTS	VTS operator The VTS operator calls the vessel to inform that they appear to be adrift/dragging anchor, and to ask if they need assistance. The VTSO asks what has happened and if the engines are running.
	OOW The vessel confirms they are dragging anchor, and are adrift due to strong winds but informs that they are working or regaining control over the vessel, and they do not need assistance, so far. Their engines are running.
