Chalmers University of Technology is one of nine European partners of the Maritime Education and Training Erasmus+ project, Digital Education for Maritime Communication (DigiMar 2024-2026), who focuses on developing **digital learning for maritime routine communication**.

All the tools that we publish are aligned with **international standards** and will serve any seafarer or shore officer who needs to cope with **routine communication** in English. All the tools can be used for **lifelong learning**, as free, easily accessible maritime language practice at any given time.

Some of our digital learning tools are now under **trial and evaluation**. This step is critical for further development and finalisation of all materials. For this purpose, we ask **external stakeholders** to try them out and give us feedback before the beginning of May.
