DESCRIPTION	VTS station contacts motor vessel to inform that they have not made a pilot order
PARTICIPANTS	VTS operator and officer on the bridge
	<p>VTS operator</p> <p>The VTS operator contacts the vessel to ask arrival time for pilot station and informs the officer of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Operator asks vessels arrival time to the pilot station - The vessel has not made a pilot order - A pilot order must be placed by email or telephone min 24 hours before arrival to the pilot station (orders are not accepted via VHF) - Boarding arrangements will only be confirmed via VHF channel 67 one hour before arrival - The officer is requested to make the pilot order immediately via telephone
	<p>Officer on the bridge</p> <p>The officer of the watch answers and acknowledges all information from the VTS operator and confirms the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Arrival time is 2100 local time, four hours from now - The vessel has not yet made a pilot order - The officer requests the contact details for the pilot centre (telephone number) and informs that order will be made immediately - The officer is aware that boarding arrangements will be confirmed via VHF channel 67
